




STANDARD STEEL PARTITION - GM








ASSEMBLING LEFT, CENTER and RIGHT PANELS

Align holes in Panels as shown and secure using: (8) 1/4-20 x 3/4 Carriage Bolts (8) 1/4 Flat Washers


(8) 1/4-20 E-Stop Nuts







APPLICABLE TO PARTITIONS WITH TEMPORARILY SECURING HINGED DOOR **RIGHT PANEL** Align holes in Right Panel as shown and secure using: (2) 1/4-20 x 3/4 Carriage Bolts (2) 1/4-20 E-Stop Nuts NOTE: THIS HARDWARE WILL BE REMOVED AFTER ASSEMBLY AND INSTALATION IS COMPLETED






ATTACHING HANDLE




HINGED DOOR





Insert the Round Handle into door cutout, so that the locking mechanism fits through the slot in the Center Panel. **NOTE: Be sure the Locking Mechanism** is parallel to the floor before attaching the inside Handle.






Attach the Plastic Latch Cover Plate and the Chrome inside Handle firmly to the back of the Round Handle. Be sure the inside handle is parallel to the floor, but facing the opposite direction of the locking mechanism.



Once the handle is installed, turn clockwise to open from the outside, and counter clockwise to open from the inside.




Align holes in Left Panel as shown and secure using:

(4) 1/4-20 E-Stop Nuts

ATTACHING RIGHT SIDE PANEL




Align holes in Right Panel as shown and secure using:

(4) 1/4 Flat Washers








ATTACHING TOP PANEL

Align holes in Top Panel as shown and secure using:
(4) 1/4-20 x 3/4 Carriage Bolts
(4) 1/4 Flat Washers
(4) 1/4-20 E-Stop Nuts

TORQUE SETTING:

Size – 1/4 = 7 – 9.5 Ft.-Lbs.



MOUNTING LOCATIONS

Position assembled partition into van. Use a 90degree straight edge to align the partition. Use C-clamps to temporarily secure partition in place. Mark holes in Headliner, B-Pillars and Floor using a hammer and center punch. For ease of drilling move partition and drill 3/8" pilot holes at locations shown. Next install Plusnuts (SEE Pg. 11)



Replace assembled partition and secure using: (4) 1/4-20 x 3/4 HWH Screws (4) 1/4 Split Lock Washers






INSTALLED PLUSNUTS

Replace assembled partition and secure using: (4) 1/4-20 x 1-1/4 HWH Screws Grd 8 (4) 1/4 Split Lock Washers






Secure the Left and Right Attachment Panels to the B-Pillars using:




